

SPECIAL RULES FOR THE TOURNAMENT MACHINE TOUR 2021-2022

These rules set out the special conditions and the practical details specific to the Competition **TOURNAMENT MACHINE TOUR 2021-2022**. For all other matters, please refer to the General Competition Rules of the Company, which is attached and forms an integral part hereof and is available at www.circus.be.

Participation in this competition constitutes full and unreserved acknowledgement and acceptance of these special rules and the General Competition Rules. No dispute will be accepted.

A. Competition name: **TOURNAMENT MACHINE TOUR 2021-2022**

B. Organizer: CIRCUS BELGIUM S.A. Rue des Guillemins 129 – 4020 Liège (hereinafter the “Company”)

C. Competition duration and location: The 3 rounds of the Tournament machine tour 2021-2022 will take place from 15 November 2021 to 6 February 2022, according the schedule below:

- From 15 November to 5 December 2021 in the Circus Casino establishments in Arlon, Couvin, Havay, Jemeppe, Liège Saint-Denis, Verviers, Grobbendonk, Boutersem and Gosselies.
- From 13 December 2021 to 2 January 2022 in the Circus Casino establishments in Aubange, Anvers, Quiévrain, Chapelle, Houthalen, Longdoz, Boortmeerbeek, Braine et Fleurus, and Huy.
- From 17 January to 6 February 2022 in the Circus Casinos establishments in Bonnelles, Lier, Pecq, Loverval, Mol, Rocourt, Herstal, Holsbeek, and Marche as well as the grand Casino de Namur. *

*Circus Belgium reserves the right to add or delete a Circus Casino establishment from this list.

D. Territorial limits: Belgian territories

E. Conditions for participation: Prior registration at Circus.be, presence in a Circus establishment on the aforementioned dates and participation in a 3-minute game session on Heroes Adventure.

F. The running of the Competition

1. Participation in the Competition as it is

Having a Circus.be account and taking part in a Circus establishment.

The Competition will take place as follows:

- People with a Circus.be account and who are in a Circus establishment when there are tournament machines present on the aforementioned dates in the establishment they are visiting can take part in the event.
- Each person fulfilling the conditions set out below can take part in the ongoing tournament once per round of the tournament in a single gaming hall of their choice. A person who has already taken part in the competition in a gaming hall during a round of the tour will be able to take part again, provided that (i) they do so in a subsequent round and (ii) in a different room. Each person can therefore take part in 3 different gaming halls in total: one gaming hall from 15 November to 5 December 2021, one gaming hall from 13 December 2021 to 2 January 2022, and one gaming hall from 17 January to 6 February 2022.

Failure to comply with these rules, and in particular entries in the competition that exceed the limits mentioned here, will automatically invalidate such player's entry.

2. Determining a winner(s) and attributing winnings

The winners will be determined per gaming hall according to the following ranking:

1st	25,000 coins
2nd-5th	2,500 coins
6th-15th	1,000 coins
16th-25th	500 coins

One place in the ranking is attributed per person per round.

The winnings exclusively consist of coins awarded to the player's Circus.be account.

G. Terms of notification of the winner and withdrawal of prize

The winnings will be automatically added to the players' Circus.be accounts in the week following the closure of each tournament.

H. Other/Specific limits

One participation per person on an opening day between 6:00 and 1:00 am according to the opening hours of the chosen establishment.

I. Protection of personal data

The participants' personal data communicated to the Company as part of the Competition is processed by the Company for marketing purposes.

The Company devotes the greatest care to the protection of personal data that the participants provide. Participants are informed that their names and contact details will be processed according to the terms and conditions set out in the aforementioned Privacy Policy. This data will be included in an address file that can be made available to third parties and/or that can be

used internally or for commercial purposes ("direct marketing"). Any participant can request a copy of the data concerning them and have it rectified. They may, at their request and free of charge, oppose the processing of data concerning them by Circus.
